

### A Message from Fr. Brian

At Mass this Sunday, we'll hear portions of Psalm 92, including the line, "It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praise to your name, Most High." Indeed, in our daily prayers we should render thanks to God for the countless blessings that He showers upon us. Everything that we have (apart from our sins) comes from the provident hand of God.

In addition to thanking God every day for the many blessings that He has given me, I also thank Him for this wonderful parish of OLS. All of you have made this such a strong and vibrant parish where God's presence is so clearly felt. I give thanks and praise to the Lord for that!

One way that you have brought so much to this parish is through your participation in our Capital Campaign. I'm happy to report that 196 families have now pledged \$1,037,095 to this campaign and we have collected \$556,920.23 of that pledged amount. Thank you from the bottom of my heart!!!

I now must call upon your generosity again in support of the Archdiocesan Annual Appeal. This annual collection funds essential programs and ministries at the heart of our Catholic mission. It supports the efforts of the Archdiocese in proclaiming the Gospel, of passing on the faith to future generations, and of caring for the poor and those on the margins. While we do an awful lot in those areas here at OLS, there are many other programs and ministries in which we are not directly involved but which we are nevertheless called to support that are funded through the Annual Appeal. Our parish goal this year is \$85,107. If we meet our goal in funds collected by June 30th, our parish will receive a rebate in the amount of approximately \$18,000.

Christ. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that "a good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good." Thank you for the goodness in your heart!

This Lent, we are offering a Parish Mission, which will be conducted by the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal (CFRs) on March 24, 25, and 26. Believe me, it is not easy to book this


