# A Message from Fr. Brian

In this Sunday's first reading from the First Book of Kings, we hear about the woman who makes a meal for the prophet Elijah. Well, our sincere thanks to our parish's Knights of Columbus Council who made a delicious meal for us last Sunday: a pancake breakfast after our 10:00 and 11:30 Masses! While Elijah the prophet didn't attend the pancake breakfast, about 150 other people did and the Knights did a fantastic job ensuring that everyone was well fed.

The Knights have been a wonderful presence in our parish for the last couple of years and have made huge contributions to the parish. The Knights of Columbus is a Catholic men's fraternal organization with nearly 2 million members. The name of the OLS Council

is *Regina Pacis* (Queen of Peace). They are dedicated to promoting and conducting educational, charitable, religious, and social welfare works, while offering men a fraternal means whereby they can proudly live out their Catholic faith with other men. #### Capital Campaign Update

Our Capital Campaign is well underway! Thank you to those of you who have already made a gift/pledge. We are very grateful for your support of this campaign! Our goal is \$1,000,000 and as of November 4<sup>th</sup>, we have \$838,228.80 in gifts/pledges from 121 families/individuals.

Because of the funds already received, we have so far completed the following projects: replacement of the church air conditioning system; painting of the religious sisters' residence; and replacement of the Nursery roof and School roof. The remainder of campaign funds will be used for: the parking lot rehabilitation; repairs to the roof of the Church; repair of plaster damage in the Church due to roof issues; the installation of new energy-efficient windows in the Nursery, sacristy and choir room; a new confessional for the Church; and a restricted reserve fund for future repair projects. All of these projects will strengthen our parish mission of building up the Kingdom of God in our midst and allow OLS to continue to be a beacon of faith and hope in our community.

We have more than 2,000 registered families who have not yet made a pledge. We ask that you consider that this campaign should not be supported only by a very small number of people, but instead by a very large majority since it benefits everyone. Therefore, we ask you to prayerfully consider a pledge.
