Fall means that our parish's activities ramp up again. We have a lot of activities ahead to nourish our faith and build our parish community. Allow me to list a few of those in the months ahead:

<u>Blessing of animals</u>: Sunday, <u>October 6th, 12:30 pm</u>: In honor of St. Francis of Assisi, we will have our annual blessing of animals. At the top of each hour, we will pray the Holy Rosary. There's one thing that we need more than anything to deal with this anxiety: prayer. An especially powerful form of prayer is spending time before Our Lord in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Attention Parents of All Students Celebrating the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist This School Year



Parents of all students in the parish who will be celebrating the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist this year are asked to attend one of two upcoming mandatory First Reconciliation parent meetings via Zoom. These very important information sessions will provide parents with an overview of the home-based sacramental preparation program used here at Our Lady of Sorrows. Parent resource materials. student workbooks, review sheets and registration forms will be distributed in advance of the meetings at CCD and through the OLS School. In order to receive the sacraments this year, your child must have attended a Catholic school or religious education program in the previous year and be currently enrolled. This is the policy of the Archdiocese of Newark. At least one parent must attend one of the two following meetings:

Thursday afternoon, September 26, 2024 at 1:00 - 2:15 pm, via Zoom

Thursday evening, September 26, 2024 at 7:00 - 8:15 pm, via Zoom

All families of our sacramental preparation students should also plan on attending our First Reconciliation Inscription Mass. This Mass will be held at the upcoming Family Mass on Sunday, October 6th at 10:00 am. A First Reconciliation activity will follow in St. Joseph's Hall immediately after Mass.
