# Message from Fr. Brian

The first reading for this Sunday's Mass comes to us from the Book of Numbers (the 4<sup>th</sup> book of the Torah) and it contains a beautiful blessing: "The LORD bless you and keep you! The LORD let his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you! The LORD look upon you kindly and give you peace!"

In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear about how "the shepherds went in haste to Bethlehem and found Mary and Joseph and the infant lying in the manger" and the grace and peace invoked in that ancient Jewish blessing descended upon the shepherds as they adored the newborn child in the manger. The shepherds then returned home "glorifying and praising God."

As we enter into a new year, I invoke that ancient priestly blessing upon you and your families. I pray that in the same way the shepherds praised God for their incredible fortune at witnessing the entry of the Messiah into the world, you too will behold Jesus Christ throughout this year and that your lives will glorify and praise God.

January 1<sup>st</sup> is the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God. It is the oldest Marian feast in the Church's calendar. Thanks to Mary responding "yes" to God's invitation to become of the Mother of the Redeemer, salvation came into the world and we became heirs to God's Kingdom. As St. Paul wrote to the Galatians in our 2<sup>nd</sup> reading, "God sent His Son, born of a woman...so that we might receive adoption as sons. As proof that you are sons, God sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying out, 'Abba, Father!' So you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son then also an heir, through God."

Who knows what 2023 will bring our way. But we can live each day of this year knowing that we have a Father in Heaven who loves us with a love beyond all telling, that Jesus was born among us to save us, and that the Holy Spirit guides and directs our lives. Not only that, but we also have the assurance that Mary, the Mother of God, is also our mother and she intercedes constantly for us. All of this is great news and it should inspire us to live this year with hope, trust, and faith.

January 1<sup>st</sup> is also the World Day of Peace. As we begin a new year, may God's peace be upon the whole world, especially in those places ravaged by war and violence. May Jesus, the Prince of Peace, inspire all of us to work for true and lasting peace, in the world, in our nation, in our communities, in our homes, and in our own lives.

Once again, at the dawn of a new year, I repeat the ancient blessing entrusted to the priests of the Old Testament: "The Lord bless you and keep you! The Lord let His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you! The Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!"

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. We now provide bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates. Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables.


