

Message from Fr. Brian

As you know, the liturgical season of Christmas has ended and we are now in Ordinary Time, which will continue until Lent begins on Ash Wednesday (February 22nd this year). Of course, time should never be thought of as ordinary. It is sacred, because it too was created by God, and so our lives should be filled with extraordinary faith, hope, and love at all times.

Looking back at the Christmas season, I think we can all agree that we at OLS are so spoiled! Actually, a better word is blessed. Allow me to enumerate the different ways we were blessed at OLS during the Christmas celebrations:

- We have a beautiful church in which to worship, which is made even more magnificent when it is decorated for Christmas. The church decorating crew included the following people: Dorothy lantosca, Mary Loeser, Joyce Ashurst, and Carol DeMeo. A round of applause to all of them for the fantastic job they did of arranging the many poinsettias!

 the live sheep and donkey and alpaca!).
- Our Religious Education Department, under the direction of Jen Noll and Colleen McDonald, put on a wonderful children's Christmas pageant. Thank you especially to: Alonzo Gallo, Carol Gallo, Gabriel Baseman, Preston Dibble and members of the OLS choir, Tom Maddi, Eileen Smith, Margaret Johnston, Rebecca Noll, and Nancy Piasecki, and especially the children who participated in the Pageant. They reminded us of the real reason we celebrate Christmas. Great job!
- You! Thank you for your attendance at Christmas Mass. And thank you for your Christmas gifts to the parish. Our Christmas collection was \$103,509, which is going to help our parish so much throughout 2023 to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to our community and your families. Thank you!
