The Epiphany of The Lord

A Message From Fr. Brian

The cover of the bulletin shows an image near the organ in our beautiful church of the Epiphany, that is, the manifestation of Jesus to the gentile visitors from the East. The visitors are variously referred to as the 3 Kings, the Magi, or the Wise Men.

The word "epiphany" is defined by the Merriam-Webster dictionary as:

- an appearance or manifestation especially of a divine being;
- a usually sudden manifestation or perception of the essential nature or meaning of something;
- an intuitive grasp of reality through something (such as an event) usually simple and striking;
- an illuminating discovery, realization, or disclosure;
- a revealing scene or moment.

These are varying but very similar definitions. They express the fact that an epiphany is unexpected, sudden, revelatory, and – for us Christians – a manifestation of God. And there is no greater revelation than that of God being born among us in the Person of Jesus Christ. The Wise Men were early witnesses to the God-man, and they brought to Him their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

In time, Jesus in turn revealed and manifested to us the Father, the Trinitarian nature of God, the Kingdom of God, the mercy of God, the power and majesty of God, our need for a church, the depths to which God's love extends, and so much more.

As we begin a New Year, one which we pray will not bring with it as many challenges as we faced in the last year, we are probably thinking of ways in which we can change something in our lives this year: lose some weight, pick up a new hobby, save more money, make new friends, fall in love (!), and the list goes on.

As we make our New Year resolutions, one resolution that we should consider including in that list is that on a daily basis we look for more ways that God continues to reveals Himself to us. As we do so, let's keep something in mind: The Divine is often found in the most ordinary, simple, normal, situations of our lives and in the people we encounter that we never would have thought carry with them the spark of the Divine. If Mother Teresa could find the Divine in beggars dying in the gutters of Calcutta, we likewise can find the Divine in everyone and in every situation. Afterall, you can be sure that the Wise Men never thought that they would find the Divine in a baby wrapped in swaddling clothes.

If we look at the people and the world around us with the eyes of faith, we'll see God manifesting Himself in so many ways, including in ways that seem so unlikely, but which do indeed reveal a completely different reality from the one we're normally caught up in. St. Peter Chrysologus (406-450) put it this way: "Today the Magi gaze in deep wonder at what they see:heaven on earth, earth in heaven, man in God, God in man, one whom the whole universe cannot containnow enclosed in a tiny body. As they look, they believe and do not question, as their symbolic gifts bear witness: incense for God, gold for a king, myrrh for one who is to die."

REPORTING ABUSE: AN UPDATE

Since 2002, the Archdiocese of Newark has formalized a process of reporting sexual abuse allegations, in accordance with the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, Essential Norms and a Memorandum of Understanding between the state prosecutors' offices and the NJ Dioceses. A year ago, Pope Francis issued an apostolic letter, Vos estis lux mundi, (You are the light of the world) that strengthened and formalized the process for holding bishops accountable. As part of the implementation of the letter here in the United States, a platform was created by an independent, third party providing a secure, confidential, and professional way to report allegations against living bishops. This service is in place to gather and relay reports of sexual misconduct involving bishops of the United States, and reports of their intentional interference in a sexual abuse investigation. Individuals may make a report online at www.ReportBishopAbuse.org or by calling toll free (800) 276-1562.

If you wish to report any other kind of misconduct by a bishop—or sexual abuse by a priest, deacon, religious brother or sister, or layperson working for the Church—please contact the Archdiocese of Newark at (201) 407-3256.




