

Volunteers Needed

For many years, Our Lady of Sorrows Church has participated in the annual Interfaith Holocaust Remembrance Service of Maplewood and South Orange. Each religious congregation in the two towns is invited to have a member represent it on the Remembrance Committee. Each committee member has a role in developing the annual service and in its goal of educating young people about the Holocaust.

The Committee meets once a month from October to June. The service takes place on a Sunday afternoon in late April or early May. Meetings usually last about 90 minutes. Putting the service together encompasses many elements, and our youth education effort offers many opportunities to use your talents to educate youth about the Holocaust. As a member of the Committee, you would have the chance to learn more about the Holocaust and to meet Holocaust survivors. You would be working with members of different faiths and would be playing an important part in keeping the memory of the Holocaust alive.
