

A Message from Fr. Brian

In this Sunday's 2nd reading, St. Paul writes to the Christian community in Thessalonica, "We always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and powerfully bring to fulfillment every good purpose and every effort of faith."

I will make St. Paul's words my own while I am in Israel, the Holy Land. Finally, after several years of planning and our pilgrimage being delayed because of Covid, 34 of us from Our Lady of Sorrows will be traveling to the Holy Land from November 3-13, to walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Be assured that, while there, we will be praying for each and every one of you, that God may make you worthy of His calling and that He will bring to fulfillment every effort of faith that you make.

While we pray for you, I ask that you pray as well for us 34 pilgrims, that our hearts may be open to the many blessings and graces that God has prepared for us on this pilgrimage. I encourage you to "travel with us" by means of our parish Facebook page (simply search for "Our Lady of Sorrows Church: South Orange, New Jersey"). I will post – daily I hope – updates on our pilgrimage.

In my mind, this pilgrimage is not just for 34 people, but for every parishioner of OLS, as we 34 pilgrims bring your prayers and intentions to the land of Jesus. All Saints and All Souls Days

The Solemnity of All Saints is on Tuesday, November 1st, and it is a *Holy Day of Obligation*. We will have Masses at 7:00 am, 9:30 am (School Mass, but all are invited), 12:00 Noon, and 7:00 pm. On this Solemnity, we invoke the intercession of all those heroic men and women who have reached the glory of Heaven. That "great cloud of witnesses" cheers us on to victory, and they shout out to us, "This is God's desire for you too: your sanctification!" May it be our desire as well.

Wednesday, November 2nd, is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). On this day, we pray for those souls who have been called home by God, but who are still awaiting entry into the heavenly kingdom. Our prayers, especially the sacrifice of the Mass, help these souls to make the final journey from Purgatory to Heaven. We will have Masses at 7:00 am, 12:00 Noon, and 7:00 pm. The 7:00 pm Mass will be a Mass of Remembrance and it will commemorate all of our deceased family members, friends, and parishioners who had their funeral Mass celebrated at Our Lady of Sorrows between October, 2021 and October, 2022. All are welcome at this Mass and a Book of Remembrance is now available in the Church near the baptismal font to list the names of your own departed loved ones.

On November 3rd, as noted already, our parish pilgrimage to Israel begins. PLEASE, pray for us, and know that we are praying for you

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. We now provide bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates.

Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables.

Food donations can be dropped off:

- Monday-Friday: 9:30-4:00 4th Street entrance (lower Church – buzz to be let in)
- Saturday: 8:00-6:00 Church front vestibule
- Sunday: 8:00-12:00 Church front vestibule
- Please do not leave food at the Rectory.


