The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. We now provide bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates. Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables. **Food donations can be dropped off:**

- Monday-Friday: 9:30-4:00 4th Street entrance (lower Church – buzz to be let
- Saturday: 8:00-6:00 Church front vestibule
- Sunday: 8:00-12:00 Church front vestibule
- Please do not leave food at the Rectory.

GET FORMED

For several years now, Our Lady of Sorrows has provided a free subscription to FORMED.org to all of our parishioners. FORMED has wonderful resources for the whole family (including young children and teens!) to learn more about our Catholic faith. FORMED provides Bible studies, documentaries, talks and movies for people of all ages so that everyone may grow in their faith. If you have not already signed up for your free membership, follow these simple steps:

- 1. Go to FORMED.org/signup
- 2. When prompted, sign us as a parishioner
- 2. Select your parish (using our zip code 07079 is easiest)
- 3. Register with your name and email address
- 4. Check that email account for a link to begin using FORMED at no cost at all.

Electronic Parish Giving

This allows parishioners to make weekly/monthly donations to the parish that will be taken directly from your bank account or credit card account once a month. 


Our Lady of Sorrows Parish invites you to keep the memory of your deceased loved ones alive by participating in our 1st annual Memorial fundraising event
