But before we jump right into Christmas, I encourage you to use this holy season of Advent to spiritually prepare yourself for the birth of Christ. To help you to do that, we offer you the following (these are all listed on the calendar on the next page):

- <u>Advent Giving Tree</u>: Please consider sharing your blessings with others by taking a tag from our Advent Giving Tree, which will be set up in the back vestibule of the Church. All gifts must be returned to the Church by <u>Noon on Sunday</u>, <u>December 19<sup>th</sup></u>. Thank you!
- Advent Reflection Booklet: We have a wonderful booklet of daily spiritual meditations for Advent from Magnificat Press. Please take one from the baskets in the back vestibule of the Church.
- <u>Seton Hall University Choir performance of Handel's Messiah, Sunday, December 5, 4:00 pm</u>: The choir from Seton Hall University, under the direction of Jason Tramm, will perform the Christmas portion of Handel's *Messiah*, a true musical masterpiece. The SHU choir will be accompanied by an orchestra and professional soloists. While this is a Seton Hall event, it is open to the public, including all of us from OLS and there is no cost to attend. What a blessing for OLS that Seton Hall has chosen to have its concert here!
- <u>Advent Reflection Talk, Monday, December 6, 7:00 pm</u>: Fr. Mariusz Koch, a Franciscan Friar
  of the Renewal and a wonderful priest and speaker, will offer us a reflection on the theme of

This event is well-known throughout South Orange and indeed the Archdiocese of Newark.
