

Message from Fr. Brian

The image we see below and the one seen on the bulletin cover shows the angel of the Lord appearing in a dream to St. Joseph, letting him know that he is to become the foster father of Jesus and that he is to take the Virgin Mary into his home. Joseph, even though he had many questions about the situation regarding Mary's pregnancy, did as the angel invited him to do, thereby showing why St. Matthew in this Sunday's Gospel passage refers to Joseph as a "righteous man."

It's interesting that in this Gospel passage we hear the word "behold" twice. Joseph was being invited to "behold" the miracle that God was doing through both him and Mary, that is, the conception and eventual birth of Jesus, the Savior of the world, Emmanuel, God with us.

Th word "behold" is a word we do not use much anymore. It's almost completely missing from most modern English translations of the Bible. But in the King James Version of the Bible, it is used more than 1,000 times.

In Hebrew, "behold" means to perceive through sight or apprehension; to gaze upon; to observe. For example, it's a pleasure to behold a beautiful work of art.

In Greek. "behold" means to know; to see; to be sure to see. For example, "Behold, don't miss this! Behold, be sure to see this!"

During this final week before Christmas, we'll be "beholding" many things: Christmas concerts (be sure to come and behold ours today at 4:00 pm!), Christmas decorations, the faces of children as they get ready for Christmas, the presents and cards we receive, and the countless other sights and sounds that surround us at this time of the year.

As we get immersed in all of the extraneous "stuff" of Christmas, let's take time to behold the most important reason for this season, that is, the birth of Jesus Christ. Don't let these days pass by without beholding the immense love that God has shown us by entering into our messy lives in order to bring us His peace, joy, love, and salvation.

And during these last days of Advent, let's remember that this is also a time of waiting. So, let's wait, and pray – and behold.

Let's behold our own yearning for the Prince of Peace to come into our world.

Let's behold a woman – Mary – who gave herself completely to God, and gave to us an example of obedience and faith.

Let's behold a man – Joseph – who left behind his questions and fears and completely gave himself over to God's plan of salvation.

Let's behold God's love for us, a love that manifested itself in such a beautiful way 2,000 years ago in the little town of Bethlehem.


Stewardship Reflections
