

February 19, 2023 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

A Message from Fr. Brian

At the end of this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers us a big challenge. He says, "Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." We understandably wonder how it is possible to be perfect and so we say to ourselves, "Easy for Jesus to say. He's God. There's no way I could possibly be perfect."

Well, perhaps our problem is that the word "perfect" isn't <u>perfectly</u> translated in this Gospel passage. The Greek word translated as "perfect" is *telios* and it means, "brought to completion; fully accomplished, fully developed; fully realized." For example, the function of a chair is fully realized (it reaches its *telios*) when it is sat upon. A delicious plate of pasta reaches its *telios* when it is eaten and enjoyed.

We Christians begin to reach our earthly *telios* when we grow in holiness, when we love more fully, when we forgive more freely, when we act more charitably, when we become more authentic disciples of Jesus Christ. This is a continual process and the holy season of Lent is our annual reminder to begin anew this call to conversion, to do as the prophet Joel tells us in the first reading on Ash Wednesday, that is, to *"return to the Lord with our whole hearts."*

During Lent, we intensify our Christian discipleship and we deepen our friendship with God. Our Lady of Sorrows exists to help you in your journey toward "perfection" and so this Lent please take advantage of all the events and programming that we are offering you, including:

- Ash Wednesday Masses: Feb., 22, 7:00 am, 9:30 am (School Mass, but all are invited), 12:00 Noon, and 7:00 pm. At every Mass, ashes will be imposed on our foreheads.
- **A Biblical Walk through the Mass:** A small group series (virtual or in person) that will help us to understand more fully the Biblical origins of the Mass and the beauty and mystery of what we do at every celebration of the Mass. This will take place on 5 consecutive Tuesdays at 7:00 pm, beginning on Feb. 28. See the flyer in today's bulletin for further information.
- Lenten Reflection Booklet: A Lenten companion booklet from Magnificat Press is offered to every parishioner. They will be at the doors of the Church this Sunday. Please pick up a copy and try to read the daily reflections. They will definitely help you to grow in "perfection."
- **Stations of the Cross:** Every Friday during Lent, 7:00 pm. Join us as we prayerfully meditate on Christ's Passion and Death.
- **St. Patrick's Day Party:** Saturday, March 18, 6:30 pm in the school gym. This celebration of St. Patrick will give us a wee little break in our Lenten disciplines! Stay tuned for further information.
- Lenten Reflection Talk: Wednesday, March 22, 7:30 pm. The husband and wife team of Dr. Eric Johnston and Mrs. Susan Johnston will offer this reflection. Eric is a professor at Seton Hall University and Susan works to empower women out of poverty through sustainable business. They are the parents of 7 children and their joint talk will offer us an informative and entertaining evening of reflection. Don't miss this!
- *Men's Lenten Day of Retreat:* Saturday, March 25, 9:00 am 3:00 pm. See elsewhere in this bulletin for more information on this wonderful day of reflection, prayer, and fellowship.
- Lenten Penance Service: Monday, March 27, 7:00 pm. Your chance to receive God's mercy and forgiveness. We'll have a communal penance service, followed by individual confessions. This is definitely a chance to grow in perfection!

Let's each of us use the 40 days of Lent to grow in holiness and perfection so that we'll be more ready to joyfully celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus on April 9th.




