A Message from Stephanie Sonnick

The Holy Spirit, dwelling in and with Jesus, is clearly on the move in today's Gospel reading! Whenever I see this in Scripture, I'm always reminded that as Catholic Christians, we believe the Holy Spirit moves not just in the stories in the Bible, but also in the life of the Church. This means that the Spirit moves in the life of our OLS Church community as well. I'm going to focus my letter today on the stories and feedback that I've heard from this community as the Spirit has moved within you all over this past year, and on sharing an opportunity we have crafted for all of you this Lent as a response.

I'm not formally trained in data science, but I am analytical: so, over the past year I have kept track of the substance of most conversations I've shared with you about your parish. (In other words: I work for you, so I'd like to report back to the shareholders on what I've heard!) One of the more common questions or remarks I've received is about community connection: I've spoken to many of you who have been parishioners here for many years who are looking to "get more connected," "plug in," or "get to know others here at OLS more than just casually." I've also heard many anecdotes and lovely stories from folks who've found great friendships and camaraderie here at OLS but would like to get to know those of you who are newer parishioners.

The second element I've noticed in my conversations with many of you is your authentic, mature hunger for God – specifically, your desire to see and hear Him in your daily lives as adults. Time is a precious resource in our culture today, and many of you are looking for opportunities to get to know the Spirit's presence in your lives that will support, not upend, your daily schedules and obligations.

In light of lots of prayer and this feedback from you, a small team of parishioners and I have created a six-week Small Group experience open to all adults here at OLS this Lent. Please join us!! Each Tuesday night from 7:00 to 8:15pm, we'll gather to learn more about and discuss a key topic of faith, starting with a video from the popular podcaster and Catholic priest Father Mike Schmitz. Groups are being offered virtually and in-person (here at the Parish) to accommodate everyone, so please join us! The topics have been hand-picked by our team to resonate with our community here at OLS to help us all connect with one another and with God, and include common questions like "what does God want me to do?" and "how do I see God in my daily life?"

So, if you are new to the parish, *join us*! If you are looking to meet other parishioners in a deeper way, *join us*! If you've been around for a while and would like to take the next right step in your life of faith, *join us*! I promise that this experience will be worth your time. 




