

A Message from Fr. Brian

In our first reading for this Sunday's Mass, Isaiah the prophets urges us to extend our generosity to those in need. He says, *"Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own."*

Last month, the parishioners in the Archdiocese of Newark received an invitation from Cardinal Tobin to participate in this year's Annual Appeal. The Annual Appeal is an opportunity for all of us to take up Isaiah on his challenge, that is, to share our resources with others, to give shelter to others, and to not turn our back on our neighbor in need.

Our financial support of the Annual Appeal provides our Archdiocese the resources to minister to the poor, to welcome those on the margins, to provide seminarian education to our future priests, and much more. Be assured that 100% of the funds collected are solely used to support the Church's ministries.

Your pledge and gift to this year's Annual Appeal will assist our own parish to possibly receive two financial incentives. Pledges made by June 30, 2023 that exceed our parish goal will make our parish eligible for a rebate. Last year, the rebate to OLS was \$14,154.

Also, if we meet or exceed this goal in funds collected by June 30, 2023, Our Lady of Sorrows will receive a 2% assessment rate reduction in our parish assessment for Fiscal Year 2024. This is a potential savings of \$18,000 for our parish. The rebate we received last year, coupled with the 2% reduction in our assessment, benefited our parish in the amount of more than \$32,000, which made a significant impact on our ability to meet our parish operating needs.

I have already made my pledge to this year's Annual Appeal. I invite you to join me by making a pledge as well. You may fill out a pledge card which can be found at the end of the pews and either mail it back to the Archdiocesan Office of Development and Stewardship, place it in our collection basket, or bring it to our parish office. To make a gift online, visit www.rcan.org/sharing. Please don't forget to select our parish name when making an online gift.

The Annual Appeal funds essential programs and ministries at the heart of our Catholic mission in our four counties – namely to proclaim the Gospel, to pass on the faith to future generations, particularly through the celebration of the sacraments, and to care for the poor and those on the margins. Please consider participating in this year's Appeal to help make a significant difference in many lives within our Archdiocese.


