

March 10, 2024 4th Sunday in Lent

A Message from Fr. Brian

This Sunday is the 4th Sunday of Lent and it is also called Laetare Sunday. *Laetare* is the Latin word for "rejoice" and it comes from the opening antiphon at Mass for this Sunday: "*Rejoice*, *Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.*" (Cf. Is 66:10-11)

Now that we're more than halfway through Lent, the Church invites us to anticipate the joy that we will experience at Easter, when we rejoice at the greatest truth of our Christian faith, the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. As a people of faith, as believers who turn to God at all times, both good and bad, we should all be inwardly rejoicing, be filled with joy, and be exulting and consoled knowing that the time of our salvation (Easter) draws near.

Given all the problems we face in the world and in our own individual lives, joy is probably not the first emotion we always experience. And that's especially true if we look at it from a merely non-religious, non-faith based perspective. But as a people of faith, as believers who turn to God at all times, both good and bad, we should all be inwardly rejoicing, be filled with joy, and be exulting and consoled knowing that the time of our salvation (Easter) draws near. Let's take to heart the words from this Sunday's Psalm (Ps. 23): "The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. In verdant pastures he gives me repose; beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul."

We have a few big evenings coming up at OLS:



Monday, March 11, 2024, 7:00 pm: We will have our Lenten Penance Service, which will offer us a chance to receive God's mercy and forgiveness. We will have a communal penance service, followed by individual confessions. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is Our Lord's idea, not the Church's. Jesus instituted this Sacrament, just the way He instituted the other Sacraments. 2,000 years ago, He gave the Apostles the power to forgive sins and this has been the normal way to receive the forgiveness of our sins and to encounter God's loving mercy. Please take advantage of this life-giving Sacrament! Receive the forgiveness of your sins that Jesus won for you on the Cross. No doubt, this will make you rejoice!

Saturday, March 16, 2024, 6:30 pm: Another chance to rejoice will be at our annual OLS St. Patrick's Day party! On my mother's side, our relatives come from the town of Castlebar in County Mayo, Ireland. Castlebar is about 20 miles from the Our Lady of Knock Shrine, where I once had the privilege of celebrating Mass. I still have many relatives in Castlebar. But on St. Patrick's Day, <u>everyone</u> is 100% Irish and so come join us for this joyous celebration! We'll have corn beef and cabbage from Town Hall Deli, hot dogs for the kids, a keg of Irish beer, bagpipers, Irish step dancers, Irish music, and lots of Irish cheer! 


LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE

Volunteer for Family Promise of Essex County

We will have an opportunity to serve those in need this Lent by supporting families experiencing homelessness for Family Promise of Essex County (formerly Interfaith Hospitality Network). We need to provide grocery items for 4-5 families and prepare a meal for each family. The meals and grocery items will need to be brought to Our Lady of Sorrows in the lower church (4th Street entrance) either on the evening of Monday, March 18 or the morning of Tuesday, March 19, and will be delivered to the Family Promise offices on March 19. The volunteer roles include:

- Cooks to prepare a meal, or part of a meal, for a family.
- Shoppers to provide grocery items for a family.
- Volunteers to help accept and store meals and groceries on Monday evening (March 18) and Tuesday morning (March 19).
