

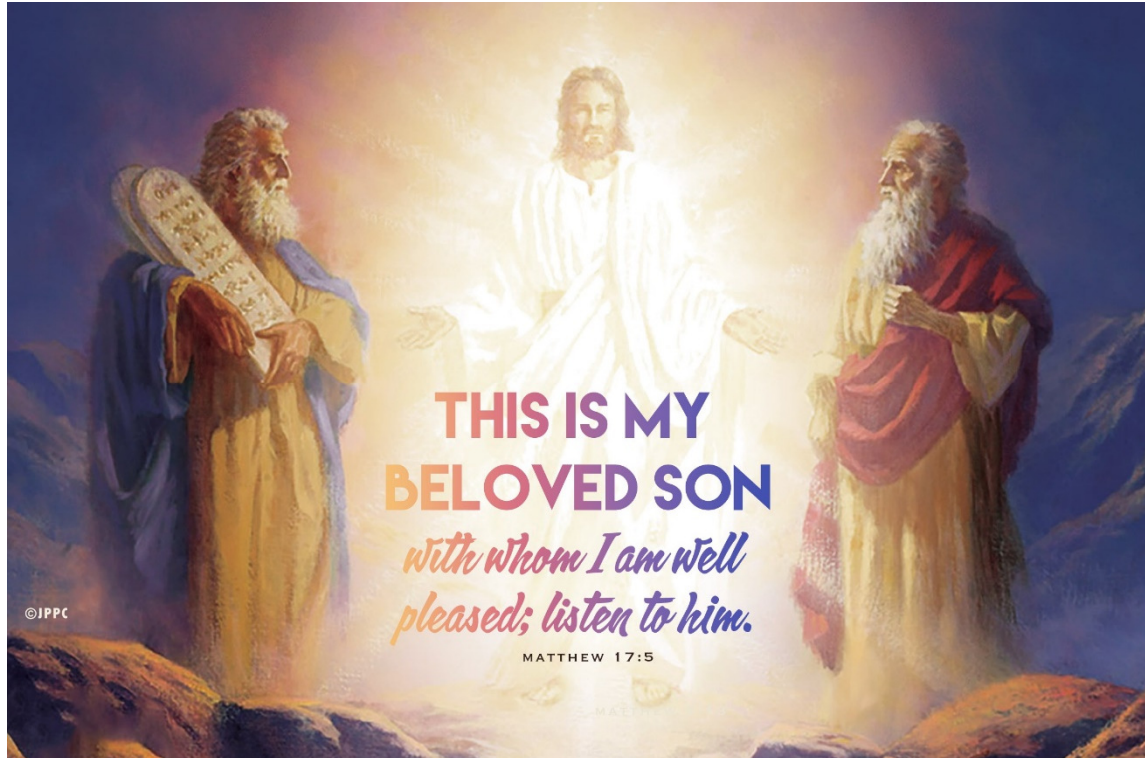

- Volunteers to help accept and store meals and groceries on Monday evening (March 27) and Tuesday morning (March 28).

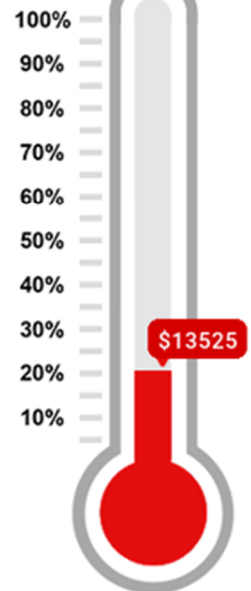
