

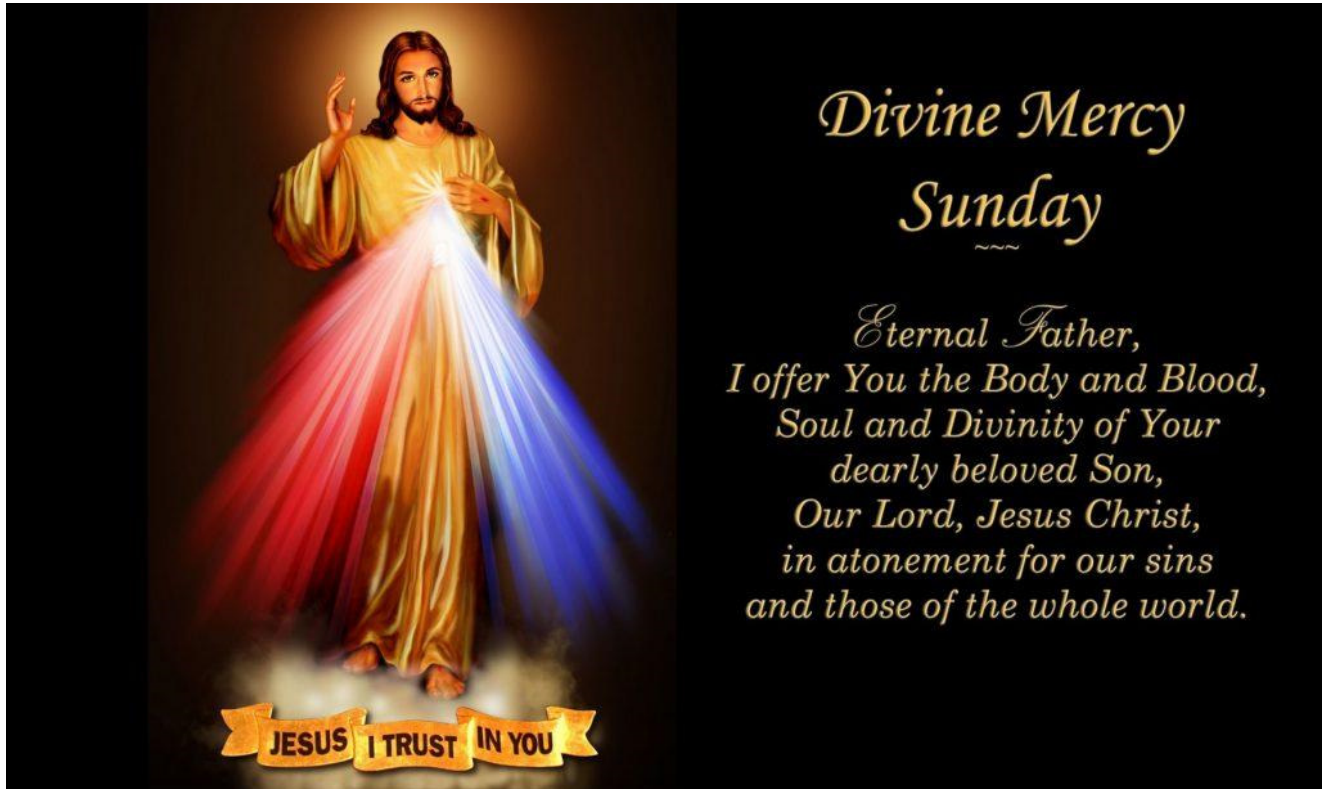

### **A Message from Fr. Brian**

Happy Easter! The Octave of Easter ends on the Sunday after Easter and so each of the 8 days in that Octave are celebrated as “little Easters.” I am writing this bulletin column on the Monday after Easter, which in many countries of the world is classified as a national holiday. It’s also a church holiday in the Archdiocese of Newark and so our parish offices are closed. It’s blessedly quiet (!) here as I write this bulletin column, allowing me to concentrate on writing about and expressing my heartfelt gratitude to all those who made our Triduum and Easter celebrations at Our Lady of Sorrows truly magnificent. The beauty, solemnity, and majesty of our liturgical celebrations took much planning and hard work.

**Our music program:** We were so incredibly blessed by the music during our Holy Week and Easter celebrations. Thank you, especially, to the cantors and choir members who led us in singing God’s praises, including our Youth and Children’s choirs. We were also grateful to have with us again at the 11:30 Easter Sunday Mass the Gramercy Brass Quintet from New York City. All of the music was under the direction of Preston Dibble, our organist and Director of Music. We were also assisted by Greg Dlugos, our assistant organist. 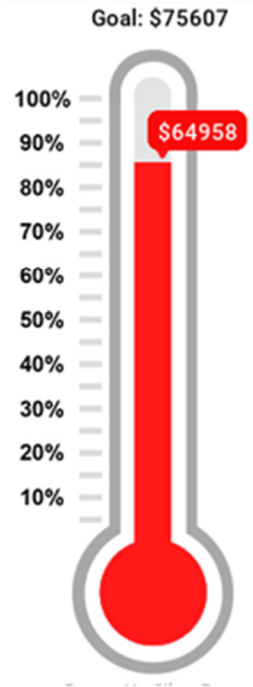
