***April 7, 2019
5th Sunday of Lent***

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BRIAN

*I fled Him, down the nights and down the days;
I fled Him, down the arches of the years;
I fled Him, down the labyrinthine ways
Of my own mind; and in the midst of tears
I hid from Him; and under running laughter.*

These are the opening words of Francis Thompson's wonderful poem "The Hound of Heaven." Thompson was born in 1859 into a middle-class English Catholic family. His father convinced him to study medicine, but he abandoned those studies. He eventually developed a very painful neurological condition and to relieve his suffering he began using opium. He was soon addicted and later became homeless. A prostitute befriended him and gave him shelter and he later referred to her as an angel who had saved his life. He died at the age of 48, leaving behind some awesome poetry, including arguably his most famous work "The Hound of Heaven."

The poem is about God's relentless pursuit of the human soul. For Thompson, God is like a great hound, who chases after us even when we flee from Him, when we do everything possible to run from him and evade Him. But God – the hound of heaven – doesn't want us to remain in a state of sin and so He continually pursues us. He chases us "down the nights and down the days."

Though God is desperate for our happiness, as the poem relates, we try to evade Him, for we too are desperate as we pursue unhealthy earthly desires and attractions. But God is unrelenting, never giving up on us, forever chasing after us and inviting us to live in a life-giving relationship with Him.

In today's Gospel, an adulterous woman is brought before Jesus. Thankfully for her, the hound had caught up to her. The Pharisees and scribes had also caught up to her, wanting to stone her for her adultery, showing no mercy toward her. But they are no match for the hound. Jesus draws a line in the sand and says to them, "Let the one among you who is without sin cast the first stone." The only response possible for the Pharisees was to walk away, their tails between their legs.

Now it's just the merciful Jesus and the adulterous woman. He says, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" She replied, "No one, Lord." And then Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on sin no more."

God continually pursues each of us too. Just as He did with the adulterous woman, He urges us to sin no more, but He also extends His mercy to us when we do stumble and fall. This Monday evening (April 8th) at 7:30 pm, together with the parish of St. Joseph, we will have our annual *Lenten Penance Service*. This is our chance to stop fleeing from God, to stop heading "down the labyrinthine ways," to completely surrender ourselves to Him, allowing the Hound of Heaven to catch up to us and offer us His merciful forgiveness. What an invitation! Let's stop running *from* God and instead turn around and run *toward* His open arms!


