

#### A Message from Fr. Brian

This past Monday evening, we concluded our small group video series entitled *The Search*. It was a real blessing for the 40 participants, who met on 7 Monday evenings via Zoom. Each Monday evening consisted of a half hour video and then we split up into small groups for another half hour to discuss the video that we had just viewed.

We all agreed that one of the greatest benefits derived from meeting like this was the connections that we made with one another. The small groups were composed of individuals who did not necessarily know each other (except to recognize each other's faces in church). By the end of the series, new relationships were formed and a real bond was created among all of the participants. We all agreed that after a year of the pandemic, it was so nice to connect with others in this way as we explored our faith together. We look forward to offering another series in the Fall when more connections can be made with fellow parishioners.

Our experience with *The Search*is just one more proof that we are most definitely made for community, for relationships, for connecting with others. Of course, the greatest connection or relationship that we can make is the one we have with Jesus Christ. In this Sunday's Gospel, He tells us: "I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit."

Abiding in Jesus and allowing Him to abide in us is the calling of every Christian disciple. When we remain connected to Jesus, we can bear much fruit in His Kingdom. But Jesus also tells us that "without me you can do nothing." A branch that is not connected to the vine withers and dies. The reverse it also true: When a branch is connected to the vine, it can flourish. When we stay united to Jesus, we can grow, flourish, and bear much fruit. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> reading from St. John makes the same point, and he connects this union with Christ with the keeping of the commandments, especially the command to love one another. He writes, "Those who keep his commandments remain in him, and he in them."

Some of the ways that we can remain connected to Jesus the Vine is through personal and liturgical prayers, especially our participation at Mass; by frequent reception of the Eucharist; by receiving His forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation; by daily reading of the Scriptures; by a lively devotion to Mary, His Mother and our Mother; and by serving one another through acts of charity. There are, of course, dozens of other ways for us to remain more closely united to Jesus. I encourage you to make an examination of conscience and ask yourself how closely you are united to Christ and His Church, how deep your relationship is with Jesus, whether you're bearing real fruit for His Kingdom, and whether you are allowing yourself – the branch – to be nourished daily by Jesus – the Vine.

The wonderful thing of abiding in Christ and allowing Him to abide in us is that this results not only in being united with Jesus, but with us becoming more and more like Jesus in the process. As St. Paul said, "It is no longer I who live but Christ who lives within me" (Gal 2:20).




