

MAY 7, 2023 Fifth Sunday of Easter

#### A Message from Fr. Brian

The old *Baltimore Catechism* asks the question, "Why did God make me?" The answer is, "God made me to know Him, to love Him, and to serve Him in this world and to be happy with him forever in the next (Heaven)." Reaching Heaven MUST be the overriding goal of each one of us. What could be better than spending eternity with God in Heaven, together with our Blessed Mother Mary, all of the angels, and saints, and all of our loved ones who have gone home to God before us?

As we hear in this Sunday's Gospel, Christ has already prepared a place for us there. What's Heaven like? I don't exactly know. Nobody does. St. Paul said, "*Eye has not seen, and ear has not heard, and what has not entered the human heart, what God has prepared for those who love him.*"

So, how do we get to Heaven? Well, it's not rocket science. We get to Heaven by following Jesus there. In this Gospel passage, Jesus says, *"I am the Way and the Truth and Life."* If we believe that and if we try to live it out in our daily lives, then sure enough we'll find our way to Heaven.

Jesus tells us that He is the <u>*Way*</u>. He's telling us to come follow Him on the path that He sets before us. He reveals that path – that way – to us through Scripture, through the Church, through prayer, and through the beautiful witness of holy people around us.

When we follow Jesus, when He is truly our Way, we never get lost. I'm so grateful for the GPS in my car and on my cell phone. GPS prevents me, who doesn't have a great sense of direction, from getting lost.

We follow the way of Jesus when we imitate Him: when we give of ourselves in loving service to one another; when we deny ourselves, pick up our crosses daily, and follow Him. If we walk in His path, then we'll find our way to Heaven.

Jesus also tells us that He is the <u>Truth</u>. He tells us that we'll find the answers to all of our questions in Him. He never deceives, He never misleads, He is always right. Remember when you were a student in school? In True-False quizzes, you had a 50% chance of getting the correct response, even if you were just guessing. If it was a multiple choice test with 4 possible responses, you still had a 25% chance of getting the correct response simply by guessing. Well, with Jesus, we are always 100% sure that we'll have the right answers. And His Truth sets us free. And again, His truth is discovered through Scripture, through the Church and through prayer.

Finally, because Jesus is the Way and the Truth, He is the <u>Life</u>. By following His Way and relying on His Truth, we share in His life in Heaven. But Jesus shares His life with us not just in Heaven, but right here on earth. When we follow the way of Jesus, when we live His truth, and when we make Him the center of our life, we experience Heaven right here on earth.

This world too often offers false answers, no hope, and a way that causes us to become lost. But with Jesus, we are offered complete truth, the fullness of hope, and a way that leads us to the unspeakable joy of Heaven.
