

A Message from Fr. Brian

As I noted in last weekend's bulletin column, 40 young people of our parish received their First Holy Communion this Saturday, May 7th. We pray that they will fall completely in love with Jesus, who they received for the very first time in the Eucharist, and that they will desire to be fed by Him in Holy Communion every single week at Mass. May every time they receive the Eucharist remind them of their First Communion and how much God loves them.

We thank Jen Noll, our Catechetical Coordinator, and Colleen McDonald, our Administrative Assistant for CCD, for the enormous amount of work that they have put in to help our young children and their families arrive to this point in their journey of faith. We're also very grateful to the CCD catechists and OLS school teachers who helped to prepare our young people to receive this most wondrous sacrament.

This past week was our last week of CCD classes before summer. Allow me to take this opportunity to thank our amazing catechists. They give so much of themselves to share the faith with our young students. There's an old expression: "If we don't teach our children to follow Christ, the world will teach them not to." We thank our catechists for teaching our children to follow Christ. God bless and reward you!

Today is, of course, Mother's Day, when we thank God for the gift of our mothers and all those in our lives who have mothered us in one way or another. Not a day goes by that I don't think about my own mother (the best mother ever!), who returned home to the Lord in 2008. Mothers are a reflection of God's love and we pray for all mothers today, that they may experience God's blessing not just today, but every day, and that their children will honor and treasure them always and in all ways.

God has blessed us not just with an earthly mother, but a Heavenly Mother as well. As He hung upon the Cross, Jesus gave us His Blessed Mother Mary. We should turn to our Blessed Mother every day, placing ourselves under her mantle and seeking her powerful intercession in our lives. At the end of our 10:00 am Mass this Sunday, we will have a May Crowning ceremony. What a wonderful way to show our love and devotion to Mary our Mother!

This Sunday is also referred to as Good Shepherd Sunday. Even though we may sometimes walk in the dark valley, we should not fear, for Jesus our Shepherd is with us to bring us His comfort and to guide us into verdant pastures.

Good Shepherd Sunday is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of this day is to fulfill Jesus' command that we "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest." We are experiencing a definite shortage of vocations to the priesthood and our prayers are needed now more than ever. We pray especially that a young person from our own parish might respond to God's invitation to work with Him in the harvest. I am absolutely certain that right at this very moment God is calling one or more young people from OLS to a priestly or religious vocation. Let's pray that they are open to that call and that they respond to it generously. I am so glad that I responded to God's call and I would not trade my priesthood for anything in the world. I pray that other young men and women may know the joy of experiencing the humbling but great gift of a priestly or religious vocation. This prayer by Pope St. John Paul II is a powerful one:

"Lord Jesus, as You once called the first disciples to make them fishers of men, let your sweet invitation continue to resound: Come, follow Me! Give young men and women the grace of responding quickly to Your voice. Support our bishops, priests, and consecrated people in their apostolic labor. Grant perseverance to our seminarians and to all those who are carrying out the ideal of a life totally consecrated to Your service. Mary, Mother of the Church, the model of every vocation, help us to say 'Yes' to the Lord Who calls us to cooperate in the divine plan of salvation. Amen."



The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. We now provide bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates. Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables.

- Monday-Friday: 9:30-4:00 4th Street entrance (lower Church – buzz to be let in)
- Saturday: 8:00-6:00 Church front vestibule
- Sunday: 8:00-12:00 Church front vestibule
