

A Message from Fr. Rich

In the Gospel of John, Jesus tells us, his disciples, that as the Father loves him, so he loves us. He then commands us to remain in his love. But how are we to do this? He instructs us that by keeping his commandments, we will remain in his love, just as he keeps his Father's commandments and remains in his Father's love.

So, there is an element of obedience, a self -sacrifice of the will, which is important in remaining in love. And Jesus commands us to remain in his love. Why? So that his joy, which exists in his love for us, may be in us. And in having Christ's joy in us, our joy is completely fulfilled. In Christ, our joy, our happiness, finds its completeness.

So, Christ reiterates his command: love one another as I love you.

And to love as Christ loves us, we must be willing to go into the depths of our existence, the very depths of our life, in self-sacrifice for others. We must be willing to undergo the ultimate act of sacrificing our self for the good of love of the other.

That is the ultimate act of heroism which Jesus shows us by his crucifixion on His Cross. Love takes courage and the greatest act of heroism we can perform. Giving our life for the good of the other. To love as Christ loves involves placing our will and our very life into the life of Christ, who is love.

As we also celebrate Mother's Day today, it is a fitting tribute to all who mother and nourish us to be reminded of the great obedience and self -sacrifice of all the women who have given themselves totally to the task of providing for the spiritual, physical, emotional, religious, mental, and overall well-being for each of us in our lives. To express our love and thanks for them should be something that we work toward and pray for everyday of our lives, and most especially on this day. To live our lives giving back to them and honoring them should be an act of true love and joy. And all of this should be done in the obedience to Christ's command to us--love one another as I love you. Then Christ's joy will be in us--and our joy will be complete.

As we ponder with love and affection all those women in our lives that have assumed the role of mothering, let us also remember Our Blessed Mother, Mary, who accepted with great love and obedience Her Son's dying pronouncement that she become Mother to us all when Christ looked down from the Cross and said to her in reference to John, "Behold your son".

We can reflect and pray on the words that St John Paul II wrote in Redemptoris Mater:

" In the light of Mary, the Church sees in the face of women the reflection of a beauty which mirrors the loftiest sentiments of which the human heart is capable: the self-offering totality of love; the strength that is capable of bearing the greatest sorrows; limitless fidelity and tireless devotion to work; the ability to combine penetrating intuition with words of support and encouragement."

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. Prior to March, we served 100-125 families each week. For the past 2 months, we have provided bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates.

Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables. Food donations can be dropped off in the front vestibule of the church Monday-Friday 7am-3pm or Saturday, 8:30am-3:00 pm and at the front door of the rectory 3-5pm Monday-Saturday.
