June 18, 2023 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Father's Day

A Message from Fr. Brian

In this Sunday's Gospel, after Jesus had selected His 12 Apostles, He sends them out to preach in His name and He tells them to proclaim to the world that "the Kingdom of God is at hand."

The Kingdom of God is, indeed, at hand and it is present to us at every moment in time. We have now concluded the Easter season and the feasts immediately following Easter (Ascension, Pentecost, Trinity Sunday, Corpus Christi) and the Church has entered into what is called "Ordinary Time," which will last until the first day of Advent, which this year is December 3rd.

In a way, "Ordinary Time" is a regrettable term because it may cause us to believe that time is somehow ordinary. But there is nothing "ordinary" about time because at all moments the Kingdom of God is at hand, for Christ walks among us and transforms our lives. In addition, every single day is holy to God, for He created it, and therefore no day is ordinary and we should find reasons to rejoice every day, even amidst the challenges and struggles we daily face.

For many of us, our fathers have worked to ensure that our lives include many "extraordinary times." To all of our fathers, Happy Father's Day! All of our Masses this weekend will be offered for our fathers, living and deceased.

We are so very grateful that we have a new "Father" assigned to us. Welcome to OLS, Father Andrew Lee! We know that you will be a blessing to our parish and we look forward to you "fathering" us!

As I did for Mother's Day this year, I reprint a Father's Day prayer composed by Jen Bober, a long-time OLS cantor and choir-member who passed away in January.

Good and gracious God, you showed us the importance of fathers when you chose Joseph to care for your Son.

Bless all the fathers who share your unconditional love with their children.

Bring comfort to those fathers who have lost children, or are estranged from their children, and all those who mourn the loss of their beloved fathers.

Share your blessings with all those who yearn for a father's love and heal those wounded by a father's fallibilities.

Bless all men who mentor and nurture children who are not their own and become fathers to children who need them.

Help us, the sons and daughters of their hearts and bodies, to return their love and honor them as Jesus honored Joseph. Amen.

To those who made a gift to this year's Archdiocesan Annual Appeal, thank you! We made our parish goal for the third year in a row. Our goal was \$75,607 and we have <u>pledges</u> of \$85,113, as of June 12th. Since the amount actually <u>received</u> as of this date is \$77,781, an amount that exceeds our goal, the parish will see a 2% reduction in the amount of assessments we pay to the Archdiocese, which is a savings to the parish of about \$18,000. This reduction in assessments is an incredible help to the parish. In addition, the parish will receive a rebate of 50% of every dollar over our goal that is <u>received</u> by June 30th. Hopefully the total amount already <u>pledged</u> will be received by June 30th and therefore allow the parish to receive the benefit of that generosity. Finally, if you have not made a gift to the Appeal, there is still time and your gift, if made and <u>received</u> by June 30th, will greatly aid the parish since we will be rebated 50% of those gifts. Once again, thank you for your generosity to the Appeal and to the parish! This Sunday's Gospel concludes with Jesus saying, "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Thank you for heeding those words of Jesus!


Sponsor Certificates A reminder:
