

#### A Message from Fr. Brian

As previously announced, Deacon Andrew Lee, who was ordained a transitional deacon on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, has been assigned to OLS for the next year and we'll see him most weekends. This weekend is his first weekend with us and *he will preach at all of the Masses*! Please be sure to give him a very warm welcome to what will be his home for the next 12 months.

God willing, Deacon Andrew will be ordained to the priesthood in May, 2023. When that happens, he will be given the grace of celebrating Mass and acting in the Person of Christ to consecrate ordinary bread and wine and turning it into the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. The celebration of the Mass is the greatest act any person can participate in, because it means being present at the unbloody re-presentation of Calvary and receiving the merits of Calvary in the form of the Eucharist. And it's not just the ordained priest who is privileged to witness and participate in this miracle, but every person. At Mass, Heaven meets earth and we are fed with the Bread of Life, which nourishes us in ways we can't even image. As we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christ this weekend, let us recognize what an incredible privilege it is to do so.

St. Francis of Assisi put it this way: "What wonderful majesty! What stupendous condescension! O sublime humility! That the Lord of the whole universe, God and the Son of God, should humble Himself like this under the form of a little bread, for our salvation."

And St. Mother Teresa put it this way: "When you look at the Crucifix, you understand how much Jesus loved you then. When you look at the Sacred Host, you understand how much Jesus loves you now."

Last week, the 8<sup>th</sup> graders from Our Lady of Sorrows School graduated. Our school, thank God, is very healthy right now and we have our highest enrollment in years. We also congratulate all other students who have recently or will soon graduate from grade school, high school, or college. May God continue to guide them on their journey through life and may they continue to grow in knowledge and faith. Please accompany them with your prayers.

#### Crunch time is here!

We are nearing our parish goal of the Archdiocesan Annual Appeal, but we need your help to get us over the finish line. The deadline to make our goal is June 30th. If we make our goal by June 30th, the parish will see a reduction of 2% in the assessment rate we pay to the Archdiocese. Because we made our goal last year, the parish saw a reduction of \$18,000 in the amount of assessments we paid to the Archdiocese. In addition, we received a rebate of \$24,000 because that's the amount we went over our goal last year. It would be great if we could match that number this year, but we need your help. While parents are the primary educators in matters of the faith, you don't have to do it all alone. Let your parish help you! #### Attention Parents of Rising First Graders

Is your child entering first grade this fall? If so, please note that the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist are received in the second year of religious education, generally in second grade. It is the policy of the Archdiocese that children must have two years of religious education before receiving these sacraments. So, don't delay, register your child for CCD today and start him or her on the road leading to Christ in the celebration of the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist.

#### St. Gianna Pro-Life Ministry

As our nation awaits the Supreme Court's decision this June of the much talked about court case, Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health, we must continue to pray for a pro-life outcome, that the Justices will make the right decision for the protection of babies in the womb.

We also need to pray for our own state as Gov. Murphy nears a decision on whether to mandate that health insurance plans provide abortion coverage through all 9 months of pregnancy (in New Jersey, a woman can obtain an abortion at any time up until the moment of birth).
