Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

A Message from Fr. Brian

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. While nowhere in Scripture do we read the phrase "Holy Trinity" or "Blessed Trinity," that doesn't mean that Scripture is silent about the Triune nature of God. There are many passages that give clear evidence that God is one, in a Trinity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Here are just a few:

- "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one!" (Deut. 6:4)
- "I am the LORD, and there is no other; Besides Me there is no God." (Isa. 45:5)
- "There is no God but one." (1Cor. 8:4)
- "And after being baptized, Jesus went up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming upon Him, and behold, a voice out of the heavens, saying, 'This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased.'" (Matt. 3:16-17)
- "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." (Matt. 28:19)
- Jesus said: "I and the Father are one." (John 10:30)
- "He who has seen Me has seen the Father." (John 14:9)
- "He who beholds Me beholds the One who sent Me." (John 12:45)

So, what's the relevance for you and me? This teaching about the Trinity has major implications for us. We are all created in the image and likeness of the Triune God. This should completely influence how we look at ourselves and how we treat one another. Let's be sure to contemplate – not just on Trinity Sunday, but always – how we and everyone around us is created as an image of the Blessed Trinity.

As was announced on the weekend of May 27-28, Fr. Andrew Lee, who was ordained a priest of Jesus Christ on May 27th, has been assigned as parochial vicar to Our Lady of Sorrows. This is an extraordinary blessing for our parish! Fr. Andrew will bring so much life, love, and faith to OLS.

Before we became aware of this assignment, we had announced that Fr. Andrew would return to OLS for the 11:30 Mass on Sunday, June 11th to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving for the year he spent here as a transitional deacon. Since his priestly assignment to OLS begins on June 17th, he will no longer be coming on June 11th. Instead, the first time he returns to us will be on the weekend of June 17-18 and we'll warmly welcome Fr. Andrew on that weekend. It's an appropriate weekend to do so since it's Father's Day weekend and Fr. Andrew is, indeed, a Father!

As I noted in last week's bulletin, 40 of the young people of our parish were confirmed at the 5:30 pm Mass this Saturday (June 3rd). Congratulations to them and their families! We are especially grateful to Chris Kaiser and Colleen McDonald for all of the hard work they have done in helping to prepare these young people for the reception of this Sacrament. Thank you as well to the catechists and teachers who, through the years, have helped form them in the faith. May the Holy Spirit they have received lead, guide, and direct them at every moment of their lives.

This is graduation season, including for 16 of the OLS School 8th graders who will graduate this Friday, June 9th. We also congratulate all other students who have recently or will soon graduate from grade school, high school, or college. May God continue to guide them on their journey through life and may they continue to grow in knowledge and faith. Let us all accompany them with our prayers.


Mass in Honor of St. Josemaria Escriva June 17th at 10:30 AM

Update from the OLS Food Pantry

The OLS Food Pantry is very busy and demand for our services remain high. We are serving nearly 200-250 families with each pantry distribution. For the calendar year 2023, this amounts to 8,341 bags of groceries provided to 6,773 families made up of 25,066 individuals. In addition to the staple items, each family receives fresh produce and milk with each distribution. This would not be possible without the generosity of Our Lady of Sorrows Church, its parishioners, and the surrounding community. Thank you!

Please continue to help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items, including hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna/chicken and rice. Food donations can be dropped off in the lower church (4th Street entrance - buzz to be let in), Monday-Thursday, 9:30am-4:00 pm (Friday until 1:00pm) or in the church vestibule on Saturday/Sunday morning. Do not leave food donations at the Rectory. 
