

A Message from Fr. Brian

As you no doubt already know, the bishops of New Jersey have lifted the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of obligation, meaning that we are all once again obligated to attend Sunday Mass (no more watching Mass while lying in bed and sipping your coffee!). The obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions.

The obligation to attend Mass was lifted because, thank God, we seem to be over the worst of the pandemic and we are on our way back to some sense of normalcy. Of course, attending Mass should never be thought of as an obligation, but instead as a privilege. When we attend Mass, we are so blessed because we are participating in and offering, in an un-bloody way, the sacrifice of Calvary. At Mass, Heaven meets earth and we are fed with the Bread of Life, the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Savior.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christ this weekend, let us recognize what an incredible privilege it is to do so. I offer you some words to inspire us as we contemplate the incredible gift of the Eucharist and the Mass.



Update from the OLS Food Pantry

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. Prior to March, we served 100-125 families each week. For the past 2 months, we have provided bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates.

Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables.

Food donations can be dropped off in the front vestibule of the church Monday-Friday 7am-3pm or Saturday, 8:30am-3:00 pm and at the front door of the rectory 3-5pm Monday-Saturday. Monetary donations are also accepted by check (payable to 'OLS Food Pantry' and mailed to the church at 217 Prospect Street) or online at https://olschurch.com/parish-giving/

STATEMENT OF THE NEW JERSEY BISHOPS

Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society.

Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180).

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).

Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives (communion in the hand, communion under one species, etc.) in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop.
