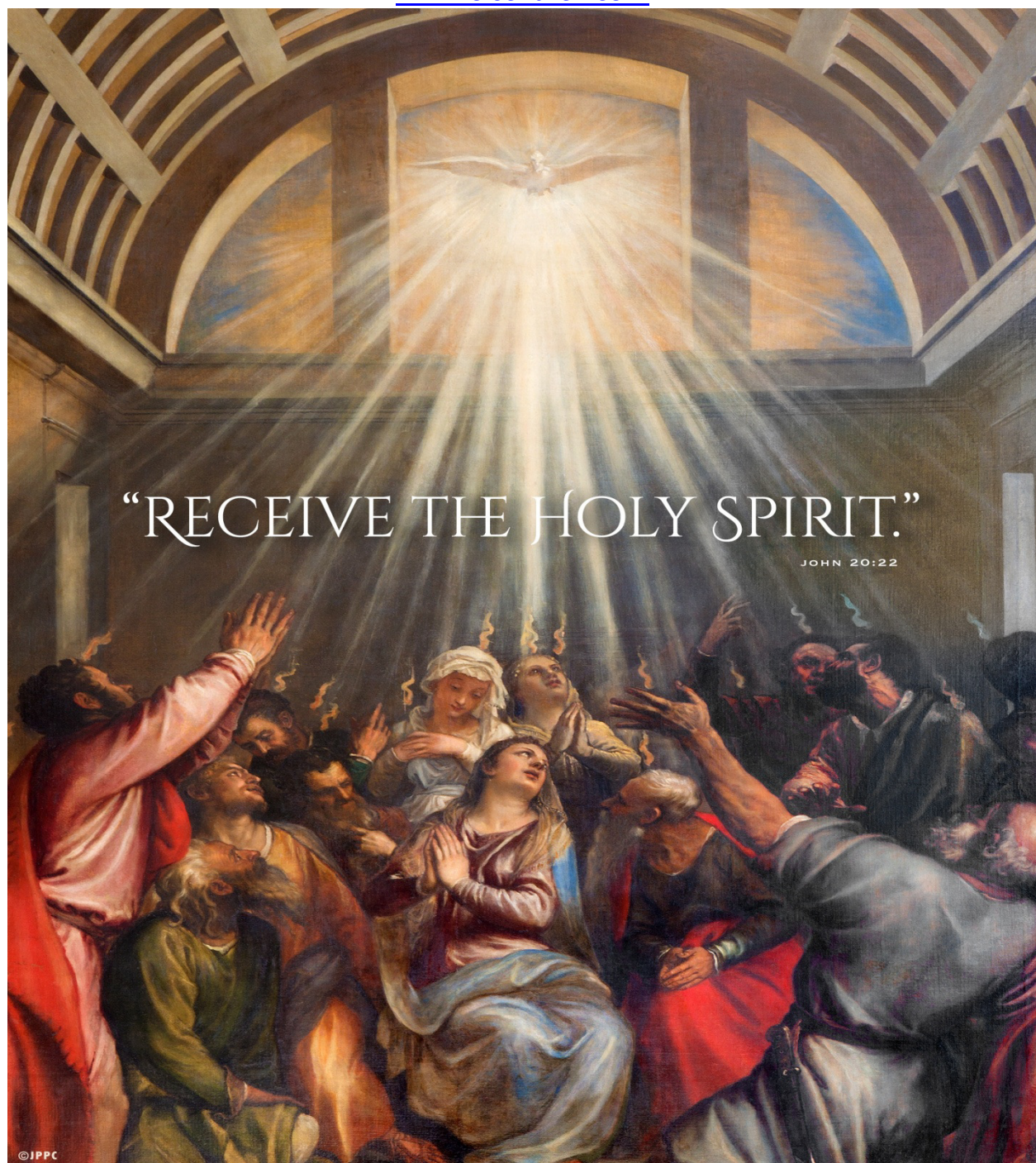

Pentecost Sunday

A Message From Fr. Brian

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, signaling the arrival of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church. The word Pentecost means "50th day," for it was on the 50th day after Easter (if we count both Easter and Pentecost) that the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples and our Blessed Mother and breathed new life into the Church.

That same Holy Spirit descended this weekend upon 48 youth of our parish and St. Joseph Parish in Maplewood, as they celebrated their Confirmation, which was administered by Msgr. Emery. Welcome back, Msgr. Emery! Special thanks to Chris Kaiser, our Youth Minister, Colleen McDonald, our Religious Education assistant, and all of the OLS School and CCD teachers who in any way prepared our students for their Confirmation. Thank you! We pray that our students will allow the Holy Spirit to lead, guide and direct all of their thoughts and actions.

In the minds of many Catholics, the Holy Spirit is the Great Unknown. But perhaps you know more about the Holy Spirit than you think. For example:

- The Holy Spirit overshadowed Mary at the Annunciation and helped her to conceive Jesus (Mt 1:18-20).
- The Holy Spirit filled St. Elizabeth and helped her and the unborn John the Baptist recognize Christ in Mary's womb (Lk 1:41).
- The Holy Spirit filled Zechariah, the father of John the Baptist, helping him to prophecy about the mission of his son (Lk 1:67).
- The Holy Spirit came down upon Jesus like a dove at Jesus' baptism (Lk 3:22) and then led Him into the desert (Lk 4:1).
- Throughout his public ministry, Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit (Lk 10:21).
- Jesus promised that the Father would give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him (Lk 11:13).
- Jesus also described very clearly what the Holy Spirit would do: He would teach us all things (Jn 14:26), would help us in a moment of trial to know what we ought to say (Lk 12:12), would remind us of everything He had commanded us (Jn 14:26), and would convict the world concerning sin, judgment and holiness (Jn 16:8).
- The Holy Spirit inspired the writers of Sacred Scripture and is the principle author of every book of the Bible.
- The Sacrament of Baptism makes us temples of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 6:19) and the Holy Spirit, through Baptism, makes us children of God.
- In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the bishop or his representative anoints us with oil and says, "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."
- In the Sacrament of Penance, the Holy Spirit, which Jesus gave to His first priests on Easter Sunday evening to forgive sins (cf. Jn 20:31), is sent so that we might once again become an immaculate temple of God and a fully restored son or daughter of God the Father.
- In the Eucharist and at Mass, we are constantly invoking the power of the Holy Spirit. Listen carefully at Mass and you'll experience how active the Spirit is at Mass.
- In the Sacrament of Anointing, the priest says, "Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit."
- In Holy Matrimony, the Holy Spirit is the one who unites spouses in love, just as the Holy Spirit is the unity between the Father and the Son.
- Finally, in Holy Orders, the Holy Spirit is called down to sanctify priests in the prayer of consecration, to make them in reality what Christ calls them to be.

See, you know more about the Holy Spirit than you thought! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love!

New Organist and Director of Music

As was announced at last weekend's Masses, Our Organist and Director of Music, Glenn Devitt, is retiring after 19 years of service to our parish, effective July 31. We are all very grateful to Glenn and all of our choir members for building such an outstanding program, one that helps us to encounter God's glory and majesty. Thank you, Glenn!

While nobody can replace Glenn, his position does need to be filled. We are incredibly fortunate to have already found someone to do so. Preston Dibble will become our Organist and Director of Music on August 1st. I can assure you that he will continue the great tradition that Glenn has established.

Preston served as Organist and Director of Music at the Church of the Immaculate Conception, Montclair from 2005-2019, which became St. Teresa of Calcutta Parish in 2016. There he built the Chancel Choir to an ensemble of 30, a graded Children's Choir program including a hand bell ensemble, as well as founding the parish's concert series: MUSIC IN MONTCLAIR. Additionally, Preston was appointed Diocesan Director of Music for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Paterson, NJ in 2013. There he conducts the Diocesan Choir and oversees music planning for the Episcopal Liturgies in that Diocese. Preston previously served St. Aloysius in Caldwell and churches in his native western Pennsylvania.

Preston is a graduate of Westminster College, New Wilmington and of Duquesne University, Pittsburgh. At Westminster, he earned a Bachelor of Music degree majoring in Music Education and at Duquesne, a Master of Music degree majoring in Sacred Music and Organ.

Preston and his wife Mary have been married 14 years and just moved from Morristown to Mendham last summer. In Mendham, he happily cuts his 5 acres of grass and tends a large vegetable garden at their 1906 farmhouse. Unlike most organists, Preston proudly drives a ¾ ton diesel truck which is helpful for their new property. Finally, an avid football fan, Preston follows the Pittsburgh Steelers, Penn State Nittany Lions and Notre Dame.

Once you have a chance to experience Preston's many talents, you'll agree that Preston is a perfect fit for Our Lady of Sorrows!

In thanksgiving to Glenn for his 19 years at OLS and in thanksgiving to Preston for agreeing to become a part of our parish family, let's all sing God's praises!
