

A Message from Fr. Brian

The story is told of the Beloved Disciple, St. John the Apostle, advanced in years, near the end of his life in exile on the Greek Isle of Patmos. There he lived in solitude in a cave surrounded by a few chosen disciples. Because he was the last of the 12 Apostles, every Sunday hundreds of Christians would come to Patmos for the Eucharist and to see St. John. Sunday after Sunday, his disciples would carry the frail Apostle down to the crowd. When the time came for him to preach, the crowd would come closer, since his voice was barely above a whisper. Every Sunday, he would say the same thing: "Children, love one another! Children, love one another!"

Finally, after one such Sunday, one of his disciples, carrying him back to his cave, said, "Teacher, why do you keep repeating the same thing, over and over, 'Children, love one another'?" St. John replied: "Because Jesus kept repeating it over and over."

Jesus repeats it again in this Sunday's Gospel. When the lawyer asks Jesus what we must do to gain eternal life, Our Lord once again affirms that we must love the Lord our God with all of our heart, with all of our being, with all of our strength, and with all of our mind. And we must love our neighbor as ourself. And then He gives them the wonderful example of the Good Samaritan, who crossed to the other side of the road to extend his love to his neighbor in need.

We meet all kinds of people each day carrying around with them all kinds of wounds that need healing; people who yearn to be shown compassion and love, people who need to be the recipient of the type of compassionate love shown by the Good Samaritan.

But so often we cross over to the other side of the street because we don't know them or because they're not like us. We think of a thousand reasons not to reach out a hand in friendship. This isn't because we're hypocrites or selfish. It's because we haven't fully become the kind of people Jesus wants us to be. We haven't yet become like that Good Samaritan. But it's not too late. The pagan world used to say of the first Christians: "See how they love each other." Let's make sure that the world says the same about us.

Archdiocesan Annual Appeal Summary

You did it again! For the 2nd year in a year, you helped us to meet and exceed our Annual Appeal goal! Your generosity demonstrates your love of our parish and your desire to be Good Samaritans to so many of our neighbors throughout the Archdiocese of Newark.

Our goal was \$75,607. Through June 30th, pledges totaled \$91,551 and actual donations received totaled \$79,276. Because our actual donations received by June 30th exceeded our goal, we will receive a 2% reduction in the assessment (tax) rate we pay to the Archdiocese. This will save our parish approximately \$18,000 in assessments! In addition, assuming that the total of \$91,551 of pledges made by June 30th are paid off by December 31, 2022, the parish will receive a rebate in the amount of \$15,944.

In summary, because we made and exceeded our goal, OLS can realize a benefit of about \$34,000. Thank you for your continuing generosity, which demonstrates your love for our parish and your desire to help those in our community who are in need. May the Lord richly reward you for your generosity!

Sponsor Certificates A reminder:

To receive a Sponsor Certificate for Baptism or Confirmation, you must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months. Sponsor Certificates indicate that the individual is a registered member of our parish and is a practicing Catholic and has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

Attention Parents of Rising First Graders

Is your child entering first grade this fall? If so, please note that the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist are received in the second year of religious education, generally in second grade. It is the policy of the Archdiocese that children must have two years of religious education before receiving these sacraments. So, don't delay, register your child for CCD today and start him or her on the road leading to Christ in the celebration of the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist.


Food donations can be dropped off:


