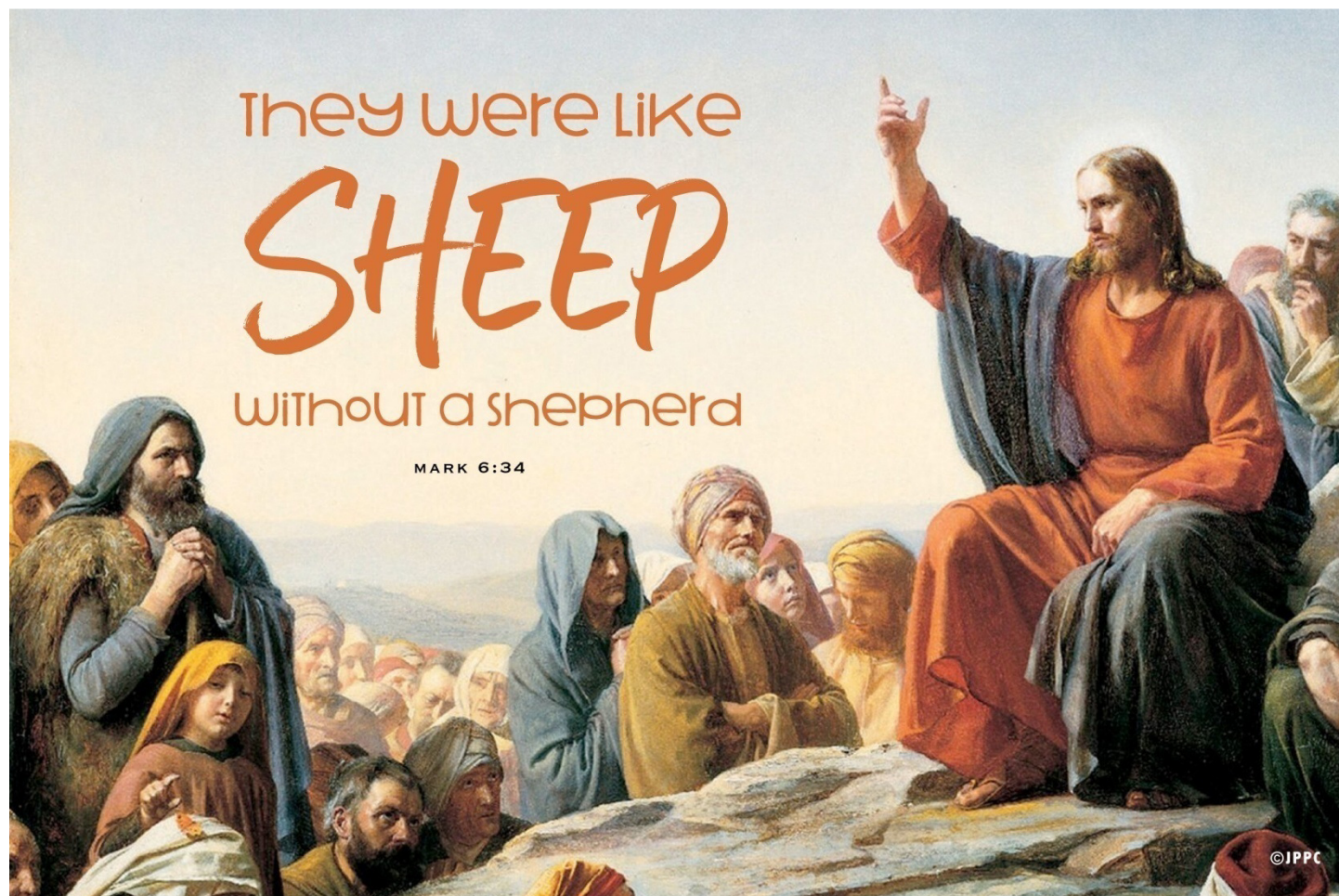

## A Message from Fr. Brian

The words from the prophet Jeremiah in this Sunday's 1<sup>st</sup> reading should put the fear of God into every bishop and priest. He says, *"Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock of my pasture, says the LORD... You have scattered my sheep and driven them away. You have not cared for them, but I will take care to punish your evil deeds."*

So many of the Lord's flock have been scattered by the neglect of the shepherds who the Lord chose to care for His flock. Nowhere is this more evident than in the sexual abuse crisis which has rocked the Church over the past several decades. Sexual abuse has caused unspeakable pain to so many people. These victims entrusted themselves to the pastoral care of priests and bishops and that trust was violated in awful, wicked ways. Our prayers for the healing of victims are necessary, but so too are concrete steps to ensure that this type of abuse never happens again. Many reforms have been enacted within the Archdiocese of Newark that seek to ensure that our parishes are safe environments for all people, especially children. But continual vigilance is necessary. *Please know that I take very seriously this responsibility.*

Some bishops and priests are also guilty of misleading their flocks by their shoddy, neglectful, or erroneous teaching of our Catholic faith. Too many Catholics have had to sit through homilies or read material that directly contradict the traditional understanding of our faith. You deserve and need to have the true, authentic faith preached and taught to you and, as Jeremiah would say, woe to those shepherds who fail to do so!

All of this points to the fact that we should pray often for our bishops and priests, that they will have the heart of Jesus the Good Shepherd. Following is a prayer from Pope Benedict XVI that I encourage you to pray frequently:

Lord Jesus Christ, eternal High Priest, you offered yourself to the Father on the altar of the Cross and through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit gave your priestly people a share in your redeeming sacrifice.

Hear our prayer for the sanctification of our bishops and priests. Grant that all who are ordained may be ever more conformed to you, the divine Master.

May they preach the Gospel with pure heart and clear conscience.

Let them be shepherds according to your own Heart, single-minded in service to you and to the Church and shining examples of a holy, simple and joyful life.

Through the prayers of the Blessed Virgin Mary, your Mother and ours, draw all bishops, priests and the flocks entrusted to their care to the fullness of eternal life where you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

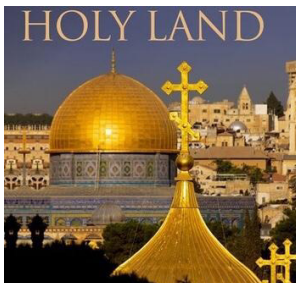

### **Update from the OLS Food Pantry**

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. Prior to March, we served 100-125 families each week. For the past 2 months, we have provided bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates.

Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables. Food donations can be dropped off in the front vestibule of the church Monday-Friday 7am-3pm or Saturday, 8:30am-3:00 pm and at the front door of the rectory 3-5pm Monday-Saturday.
