#### A Message from Fr. Brian

Did you hear the story about the man who was walking on the beach and came across an old bottle? He picked it up, pulled out the cork and out popped a genie. The genie said, "Thank you for freeing me from the bottle. In return I will grant you three wishes." The man said, "Great! First, I want one billion dollars in a Swiss bank account." Poof! His first wish was granted. He continued, "Next, I want a brand-new red Ferrari right here." Poof! A bright red, brand-new Ferrari appeared right next to him. Then he said, "Finally, I want to be irresistible to women." Poof! There is a flash of light and he turned into a box of chocolates.

Corny, I know! But it illustrates a point: Be careful what you wish for and don't get greedy! In this Sunday's Gospel parable of the rich man, we hear about a greedy man who built more and more barns so that he could store his surplus wealth. God said to him, *"You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?"* Jesus reminds us that we are fools if we store up treasure for ourselves but are not rich in what matters to God. This Gospel passage reminds us that our possessions are merely lent to us by God, that we are accountable for their use, and that we must be generous in sharing our time, our treasure, and our talents, the three elements of Christian stewardship.

Now, Our Lord isn't saying that money or wealth is intrinsically evil. It's not. What He's saying is that we're on the wrong path when we place so much emphasis on increasing our wealth or on the fleeting things of this world that we ignore the things of God. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading this weekend, St. Paul says, *"Think of what is above, not of what is on earth."* It's a reminder to us that the things of this world are fleeting. They will pass away. There is no lasting glory with them. As the old expression goes, you can't take it with you. The accountant for John D. Rockefeller, who during his lifetime was the wealthiest man that ever lived, was once asked how much money the world-famous billionaire left behind. Without hesitating, the accountant honestly answered with just one word: "Everything."
