## A Message From Fr. Brian

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We believe that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was assumed into Heaven, body and soul, where she now intercedes for us. At the end of our own earthly lives, our souls – we pray – will join Mary and bask in the glory of Heaven and then at the consummation of the world, our souls will be reunited with our bodies. 

**Baptism Prep: A chance to learn and reflect**

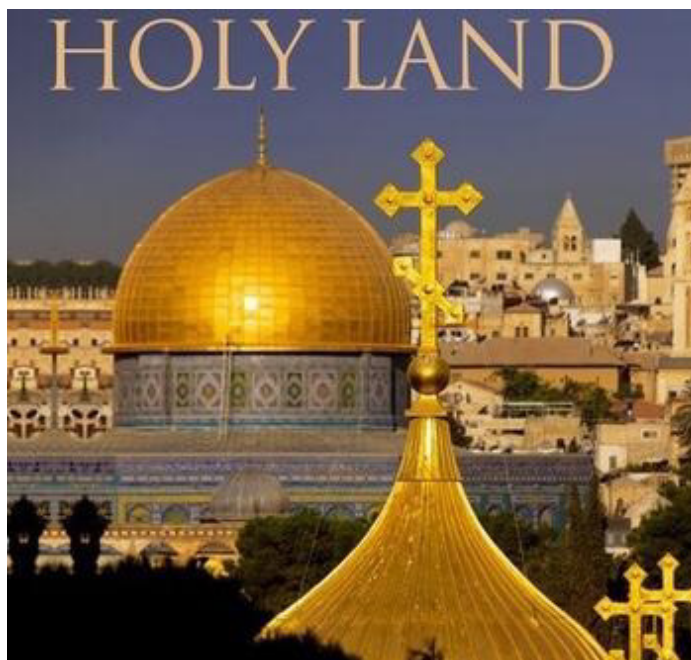
Parents who ask to have their children baptized at OLS are first asked to watch a film about the Sacrament of Baptism and then to answer a few questions. To the question of "Name one or more insights that you received from the video," among the replies we recently received were the following:

- "The Cross is the royal throne of Christ and the Chrism oil anoints us as was done with kings and prophets."
- "While we always thought of Baptism as a key milestone in our daughter's life and an occasion to come together as a family, more importantly it is a welcoming into the Catholic community and the cleansing of original sin."
- "We are not perfect, but because of Confession, we're in a state of continual conversion, and we're renewing our Baptism over and over again."
- "Baptism is a necessary part of salvation, bringing an individual into the family of God and cleaning original sin. We are each soldiers, priest, prophets, and kings, and not merely bystanders in the Church. The trinitarian aspect of the family, being the domestic Church, lays the foundation for spiritual growth of the baptized. Godparents are the link the baptized and the greater Church community, as faith is both communal and individual."

In future bulletins, we will continue to share other responses to this question and other questions. We can all learn something by reflecting on these responses.

**Holy Land Pilgrimage**

We are now planning a parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land (Israel), from March 8-18, 2022. We will walk in the footsteps of Jesus and the trip will include, among many other sites, the following: Mount Carmel, Nazareth, Cana, the Mount of Beatitudes, Capernaum, a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, Mount Tabor, Bethlehem, the Dead Sea, Mossada, and Jerusalem. 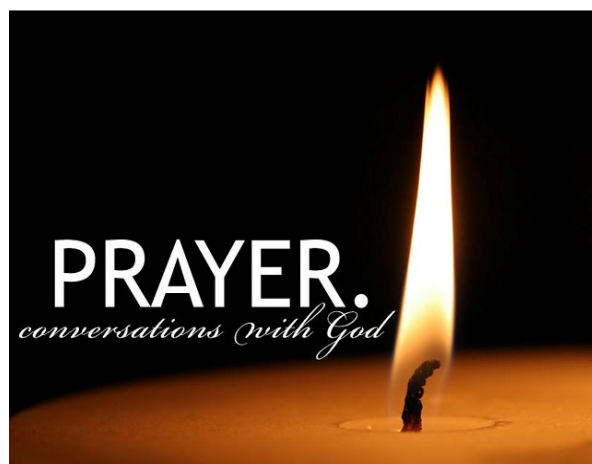
