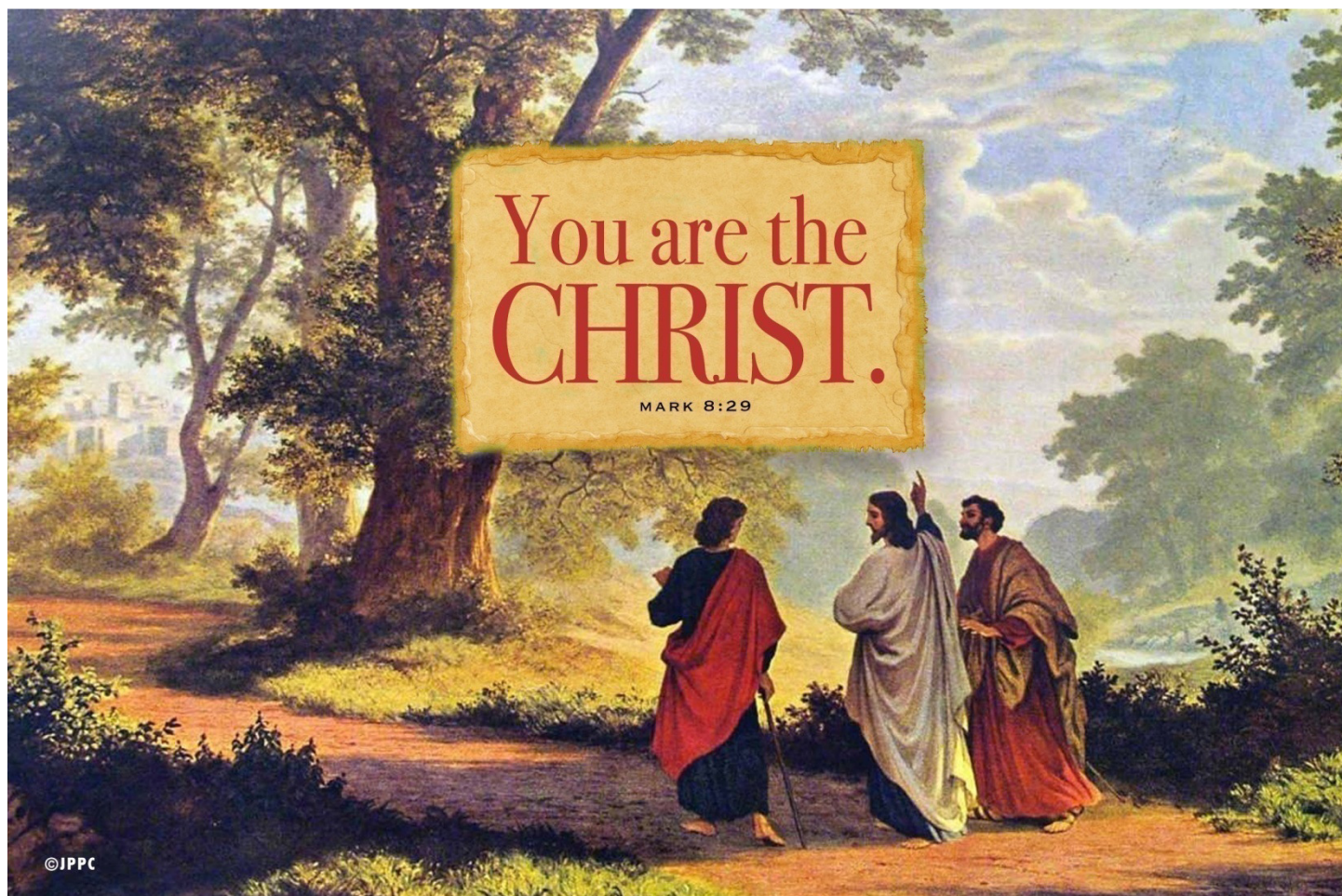

Thursday, October 7 at 7:00 pm

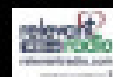
Please join us for this year's Rosary Congress.

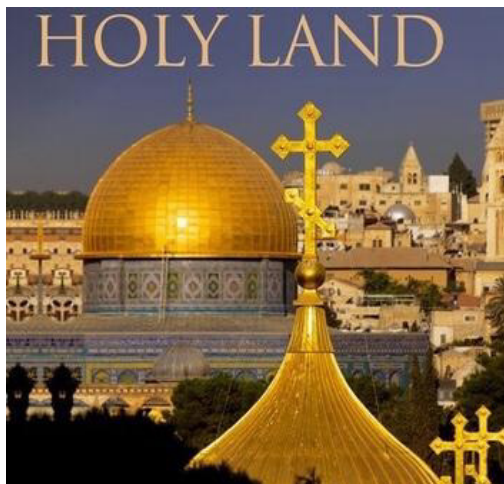

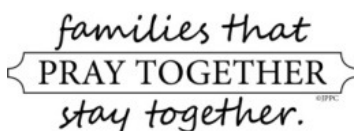

Baptism Prep: A chance to learn and reflect

Parents who ask to have their children baptized at OLS are first asked to watch a film about the Sacrament of Baptism and then to answer a few questions. To the question of "Name one or more insights that you received from the video," among the replies we recently received were the following:

- It was insightful to learn how Jesus was Priest, Prophet, and King. By virtue of being Catholics, and the parents of a baptized child, we also take on these roles. We are messengers, examples, and leaders in the faith. Our daughter will learn through us how to live in Christ.
- The importance of our own baptisms and how much that has affected our own lives and brought us to where we are today in our faith.
- The significance of Baptism restoring the holiness that was lost from the original sin of Adam and Eve, in addition to Baptism being the start of our child's spiritual journey.

In future bulletins, we will continue to share other responses to this question and other questions. We can all learn something by reflecting on these responses.
