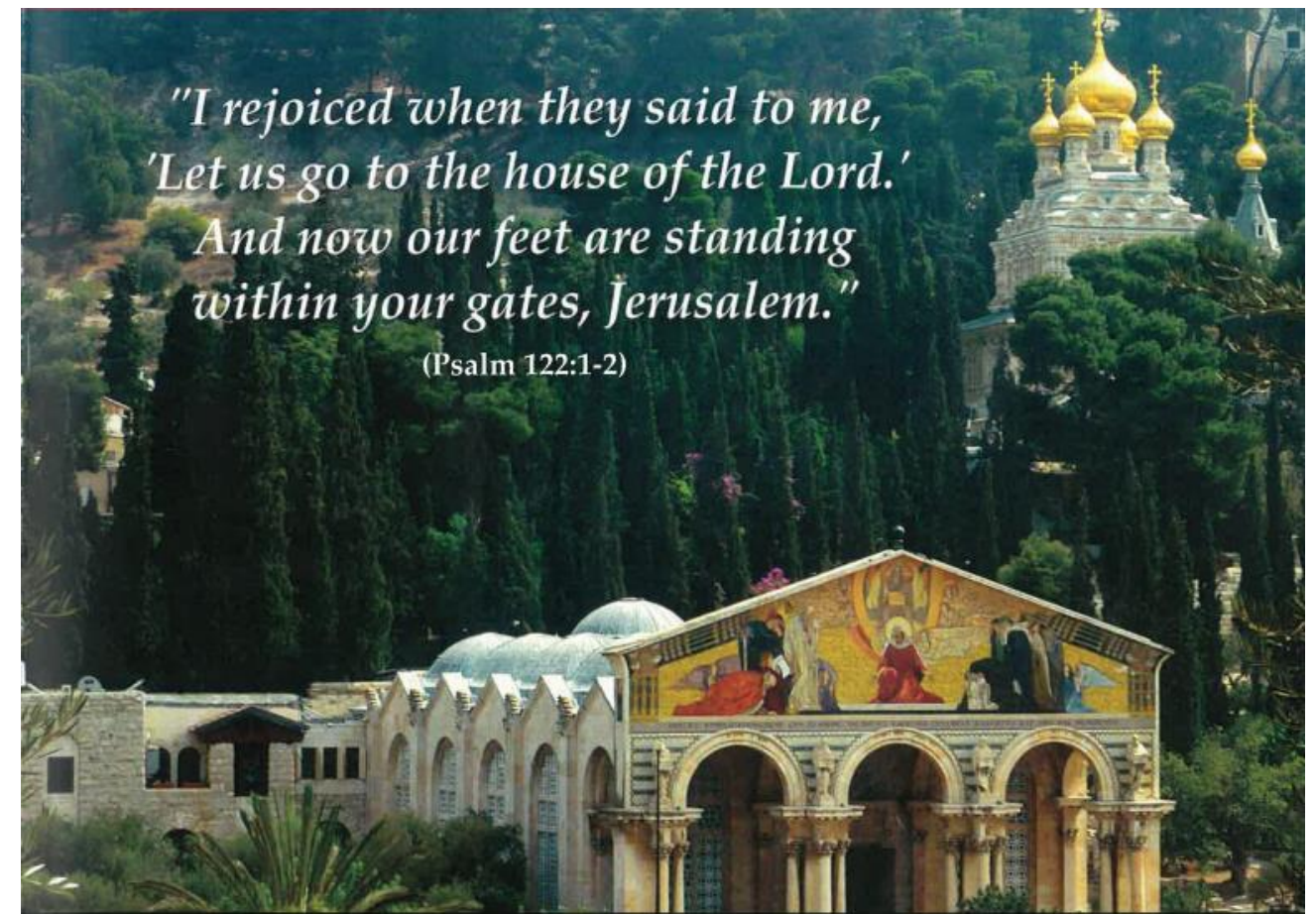

PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3: OUR LADY OF SORROWS PARISH and NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Depart from Our Lady of Sorrows at 9:30 am en route to the El Al Israel Airlines Terminal at Newark International Airport. Upon arrival at the Airport, we will be provided with professional assistance as we check in for our El Al Israel Airlines non-stop flight #28. The estimated time of departure is 2:15 pm.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4: THE HOLY LAND

We arrive into the Holy Land at approximately 6:35 am. We will collect our luggage before proceeding through Customs to be met by our Israeli tour guide, David Hyman, and our driver, who will be with us throughout our stay. After boarding a Deluxe motorcoach, we will drive along the Mediterranean Sea, past the ruins in Caesarea Maritima, to Haifa to visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Afterward, we continue to Tiberias at the Sea of Galilee to check into *The Golan Hotel*, where dinner will be served.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5: NAZARETH, CANA, MAGDALA

Our morning will be spent in Nazareth, where we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and the Church of St. Joseph. We will then have lunch and explore the village of Nazareth. Afterward, we will be driven to Cana, and you will have the chance to renew your marriage vows. We will then visit the ruins at Magdala, the village of St. Mary Magdalene. We will conclude our day at our hotel where dinner will be served.

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 6: THE GALILEE

Today we will experience the incredible peace and beauty of the area surrounding the Sea of Galilee. We will visit the Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha (the site of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish as well as the Church of the Primacy). We will then visit the ruins in the ancient village of Capernaum and we'll visit the Church of St. Peter. Next, we will board a small boat for a private cruise on the Sea of Galilee. We will conclude the day at our hotel, where dinner will be served.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7: MOUNT TABOR, JORDAN RIVER, JERUSALEM

We begin today at the Basilica of the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor and then once we descend from the Mount, we will drive along the Jordan River Valley Road to a site where we will renew our Baptismal promises. We will then travel "up to Jerusalem" and get our first view of that ancient city from the Mount of Olives. We will then check into *The Sephardic House Hotel* in Jerusalem, where dinner will be served.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8: BETHLEHEM, EIN KAREM, JERUSALEM

The morning will be spent in Bethlehem at Manger Square, the Church of the Nativity, and the caves of Shepherd's Field. During the afternoon, we will visit the village of Ein Karem (the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the site of the Visitation). We will return afterward to our hotel, where dinner will be served.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9: JERUSALEM

We will relive Jesus' final hours today. We begin at the Altar of the Crucifixion in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Next, we will visit the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations, as well as Caiphas' Palace. The afternoon will be spent in Jerusalem's Old City, as we enter through St. Stephen's Gate, where we will see the Pool of Bethzatha and visit the Church of St. Anne. We will then walk the Via Crucis (the Way of the Cross), which ends at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We will return to our hotel, where dinner will be served.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 10: JERUSALEM

We begin today at the Church of the Dormition, which is identified as the location where Mary "fell asleep." We will then walk along the ancient Roman Cardo and visit the Western (Wailing) Wall and the Southern Wall Excavation site. During the afternoon, we will visit Yad Veshem (the memorial to the victims of the Holocaust). We will return from there to our hotel, where dinner will be served.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11: MASSADA and THE DEAD SEA

We will be driven south of Jerusalem through the Judean Desert en route to experience the Roman fortress of Massada. When we conclude that tour, we will be taken to the Dead Sea, where we will have the opportunity to take a "float" in the healing waters. We return afterward to our hotel, where dinner will be served.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12: JERUSALEM, BEN GURION INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

We are free to enjoy a leisurely morning on our own, to shop or simply to rest. In the afternoon, we will be taken to Notre Dame de Jerusalem to experience the exhibit of the Shroud of Turin. We will have a wonderful farewell dinner at Notre Dame. Following dinner, we will be driven to Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv to check in for our flight home.

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 13: NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, SOUTH ORANGE

We depart from the Holy Land on El Al Israel Airlines Flight #27 at 1:00 am and we'll arrive into Newark International Airport at 6:00 am. After we collect our baggage, we will be met by a motorcoach driver who will provide transportation to Our Lady of Sorrows Church.

Mass will be celebrated daily; the Mass sites will be noted on our final itinerary.
