


A Message from Fr. Brian

Cardinal Joseph Tobin's visit with us last Sunday was wonderful! He celebrated the 11:30 Mass and he stayed afterward until the very last person had left (he spent more than an hour shaking hands after Mass). We're very grateful to Cardinal Tobin for his visit and it was a vivid reminder that our church community extends beyond Our Lady of Sorrows. We all belong to the Archdiocese of Newark and we both depend



on the Archdiocese for many different services and we provide support to the Archdiocese as it seeks to minister to so many different constituencies.

The Archdiocesan Annual Appeal is continuing and, as a whole, the Archdiocese has made 88% of its goal, as of June 4th. We at Our Lady of Sorrows have made 78% of our goal. If we reach our goal by <u>June 30th</u>, both the Archdiocese and our parish benefit. OLS will see a



reduction of 2% of our annual assessment (a savings of about \$15,000/year for the parish) and we will receive 100% of every dollar raised over our goal. If we fail to make our goal, the parish itself will have to make up the difference (this policy is new beginning this year). I know, though, that with your support we can cross the finish line!

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about the mustard seed and how even though it is a very small seed, it grows into a large bush. Likewise, our contributions to building up the kingdom of God, whether they be of our time, talent, or treasure, and whether they be big or small, are important and they help to build up and grow the church, the body of Christ. I therefore ask that, if you have not yet made a gift to the Annual Appeal, you prayerfully consider doing so before June 30th.

Learning from One Another

Baptism Prep: A chance to learn and reflect Parents who ask to have their children baptized at OLS are first asked to watch a film about the Sacrament of Baptism and then to answer a few questions. To the question of "Name a way you can nurture your child's faith in your family setting," among the replies we recently received were the following:

- "Introduce more faith-based stories at bedtime, either Bible stories or stories about the saints to reinforce the lesson learned at Mass."
- "We will ensure we share what we ourselves are learning on our journey of faith with our daughter to help foster her relationship with Christ."
- "We can help nurture our child's faith by teaching her prayers. We can help nurture her faith by singing songs and reading the Bible with her."
- "Going to Mass as a family, eating family dinners together and discussing faith and how it affects our lives; discussing currents events and how they align with our faith."

In future bulletins, we will continue to share other responses to this question and other questions. We can all learn something by reflecting on these questions and responses.

Online CCD Registration Now Open

In a sign of progress, after a year of remote learning, the OLS CCD program aims to bring the Good News to all of its students in person once again this fall! New and returning families can now register for traditional CCD classes and the OLS CCD homeschooling program by accessing the online registration form via the parish website:www.olschurch.com. Simply click on the "Religious Education" tab at the top of the home page or contact the religious education department to access our registration form. Program updates and information as well as our weekly CCD newsletter can also be found on the OLS website.

While many program details still need to be worked out pending the release of directives from the Archdiocese of Newark, CCD classes are scheduled to begin Monday and Tuesday afternoons, beginning the week of September 20th, from 3:55 - 5:15 pm for students in grades 1 through 8. A Kindergarten class will also be offered on Mondays. There are 25 weeks of classes which run through the first week of May.

Please register before July 15th to take advantage of "Early Bird" pricing and to help us determine the number of necessary volunteers. Please note, no child will be refused acceptance into our program due to financial hardship. Attention Parents of Rising First Graders

Is your child entering first grade this fall? If so, please note that the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist are received in the second year of religious education, generally in second grade. Update from the OLS Food Pantry

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken a tremendous toll on local families. Prior to March, 2020, we served 100-125 families each week. For the past 2 months, we have provided bags of groceries to 400-450 families on our Saturday distribution dates.

Please help us keep our shelves stocked with basic grocery items including boxed milk (1qt, all types), hot/cold cereal (low sugar), pasta and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, beans (can/dry), canned tuna & chicken, rice (1lb bags, all types), canned fruit and vegetables.

Food donations can be dropped off in the front vestibule of the church Monday-Friday 7am-3pm or Saturday, 8:30am-3:00 pm and at the front door of the rectory 3-5pm Monday-Saturday. ACTION ALERT - NJ State Budget

Ask the Legislature to Increase Nonpublic School Accounts in FY 2022 Budget

Governor Murphy announced his proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2022 on February 23, 2021. The Budget process is now in the hands of the Legislature. We are asking the Legislature for increases in the per-pupil amounts for the nonpublic transportation ceiling and the Nonpublic School Technology Initiative. Specifically, we are asking for the nonpublic school transportation ceiling to be raised to \$1,150.00 and for the per-pupil amount for nonpublic school technology to be increased to \$45.00.

STATEMENT OF THE NEW JERSEY BISHOPS Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society.

Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180).

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).

Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives (communion in the hand, communion under one species, etc.) in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop.
